**ORDINANCE NO. 2014-01**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF COLLINSVILLE, ALABAMA, TO EXEMPT CERTAIN "COVERED ITEMS" FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX DURING THE FIRST FULL WEEKEND OF FEBRUARY 2014, AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT 2012-256, GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS THE STATE SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS SALES TAX HOLIDAY LEGISLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF COLLINSVILLE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. In conformity with the provisions Act 2012-256 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2012 Regular Session, providing for a State Severe Weather Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday, the Town of Collinsville, Alabama, exempts "covered items" from municipal sales and use tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the last Friday in February 2014 (February 21, 2014) and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday (February 23, 2014).

Section 2. This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2012-256, except that the time period shall only be as specified in Section 1 above **and not for all years thereafter**.

Section 3. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the Town of Collinsville, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on January 6, 2014.
