ORDINANCE NO. 2016-04

AMENDMENT TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ORDINANCE NO. 2010-05

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COLLINSVILLE, ALABAMA as follows:

That certain portions of Alcoholic Beverage Ordinance No. 2010-05, adopted and approved by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Collinsville, Alabama on September 7, 2010, is hereby amended as follow:

**SECTION 3 OF ARTICLE II SHALL BE AMENDED IN ITS ENTIRETY TO READ AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 3. APPLICATION FOR LOUNGE, CLUB, RESTAURANT, BEER, WINE ETC., LICENSE; DEPOSIT.**

Each applicant seeking the consent and approval of the Town Council for lounge retail liquor license, a club retail liquor license, a restaurant retail liquor license, or other alcoholic license issued by the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, shall make application to the Town Council as required in this chapter. Said application shall be upon an appropriate form supplied by the Town Clerk, or duly authorized representative, and shall be signed and verified by oath or affirmation by the licensee, if a natural person, or in the case of a partnership, association or unincorporated enterprise, by a partner, limited liability company (LLC) or managing member thereof, or in the case of a corporation, by an executive officer thereof. The applicant shall deposit with the Town Clerk the required application fee.

**Criminal History Background Check:** Any criminal history background check conducted by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall be deemed sufficient to meet the requirements of background checks of applicants.

SECTION 7 OF ARTICLE II SHALL BE AMENDED IN ITS ENTIRETY TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 7. APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS.

Licenses shall be granted and issued by the Town only to reputable individuals or associations whose members are reputable individuals or to reputable corporations organized under the laws of the state or duly qualified thereunder to do business in the State of Alabama.


All other ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby amended or repealed.
